Dear RPS Community,

The week started off with Governor Lamont's announcement of his recommendation to lift the statewide mask mandate in schools by February 28, 2022. The Commissioner of Education, and the Commissioner of the CT Department of Health (DPH) also supported the Governor's recommendation. If you have not had the opportunity to view the press conference, you may do so <a href="here.">here.</a> As a reminder, from the beginning of the pandemic RPS has partnered with our local health committee and has followed guidelines/recommendations from CT DPH/CT State Department of Education. This newest DPH recommendation will be discussed with the Board of Education at their regularly scheduled meeting on Monday, February 14, 2022.

As with all guidance, there are details that will need to be tended to as well, just to name a few:

- Communication with students
- Current federal law requiring masking on transportation
- Screening practices
- Quarantining procedures
- Impact on extracurricular activities

While we may not have all the details fleshed out, we will provide our school community with an update shortly after our Board of Education meeting on Monday evening.

It is hard to believe that we are almost at February break. Our students will be dismissed early on February 17 and return on February 28. February break is new this year, and we ask that families not extend the holiday break beyond the allotted time. Faculty and families who are traveling and would like a test kit, please contact your school nurse. We hope to welcome all of our students back on February 28!
