PreK- Gr 6 COVID-19 Screening Program

We had a successful first day of PCR screening testing at BES, FES, VPES, and ERMS. All tests came back negative for COVID-19. Then on Monday evening we received word from the state of CT that the screening testing would be temporarily paused so the DPH could work out some logistical issues with Quest. Unfortunately, this resulted in the cancellation of testing for BMES, RES, SES, and SRMS for this week.

Quest reached out to us on Wednesday to confirm that, per a request by the state of CT, pooled testing will no longer be done. Each student will receive an individual PCR test. The experience for students will not change. Testing is set to resume Monday, November 1 since there is no school on Tuesday, November 2. Testing at all schools will be done on Monday only next week and will resume on Mondays and Tuesdays the following week. About 50 additional students have been enrolled in the program since last week. We now have 520 students participating. If

you would like to opt your child into this voluntary program please sign the consent in PowerSchool by Wednesday for them to be included in the following weeks' testing.

Health and Safety

Per the CT DPH, COVID-19 vaccinations for 5-11 year olds may begin in CT as soon as Thursday November 4. This is pending the expected final sign off by the CDC on November 3.
